### Travel & Tourism

**Travel Agents:** sell transportation, lodging, and admission to entertainment activities to individuals and groups planning trips. They offer advice on destinations, plan trip itineraries, and make travel arrangements for clients.

Education: High school diploma

Average Wage: \$16.64 per hour, \$34,600 per year

**Lodging Manager:** ensure that guests on vacation or business travel have a pleasant experience at a hotel, motel, or other types of establishment with accommodations. They also ensure that the establishment is run efficiently and profitably.

Education: High school diploma

Average Wage: \$22.50 per hour, \$46,810 per year

**Flight Attendant:** provide personal services to ensure the safety and comfort of airline passengers.

Education: High school diploma

Average Wage: \$37,240 per year

**Airline & Commercial Pilots:** pilots fly and navigate airplanes, helicopters, and other aircraft. Airline pilots fly for airlines that transport people and cargo on a fixed schedule. Commercial pilots fly aircraft for other reasons, such as charter flights, rescue operations, firefighting, aerial photography, and aerial application, also known as crop dusting.

Education: Bachelor's degree & pilot's license

Average Wage: \$98,410 per year

**Water Transportation Occupations:** operate and maintain vessels that take cargo and people over water. These vessels travel to and from foreign ports across the ocean, to domestic ports along the coasts, across the Great Lakes, and along the country's many inland waterways.

Education: Bachelor's Degree

Average Wage: \$23.55 per hour, \$48,980 per year

**Dancers & Choreographers:** express ideas and stories, using dance. There are many types of dance such as ballet, tango, modern dance, tap, and jazz.

Education: High school diploma

Average Wage: \$15.87 per hour

**Railroad Occupations:** ensure that passenger and freight trains run on time and travel safely. Some workers drive trains, some coordinate the activities of the trains, while others operate signals and switches in the rail yard.

Education: High school diploma

Average Wage: \$25.19 per hour, \$52,400 per year

**Taxi Drivers and Chauffeurs:** drive people to and from the places they need to go, such as airports, homes, shopping centers, and workplaces. They must know their way around a city in order to take both residents and visitors to their destinations.

Education: Less than high school

Average Wage: \$10.97 per hour, \$22,820 per year

**Bus Driver:** transport people between various places—including work, school, and shopping malls—and across state or national borders. Some drive regular routes, and others transport passengers on chartered trips or sightseeing tours.

Education: High School Diploma

Average Wage: \$14.21 per hour, \$29,550 per year
